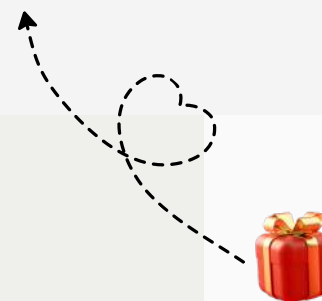

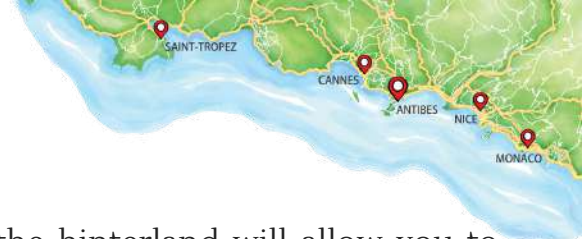

The Italian Riviera, better known as the Riviera of Flowers, is the land of colors, sun, blue skies and eternal spring. Multicolored flowers decorate the flowerbeds and gardens.

Balzi Rossi is a village near the French border; you can visit spectacular caves where Paleolithic man used to live. Not far away you can find the lush gardens of Villa Hanbury, with a wide variety of succulents.



The passage into the hinterland will allow you to visit several villages such as Dolceacqua, with the ancient castle of the Doria family, and Apricale, a village perched on the side of the mountain, characterized by narrow “carrugi” (this i.e. steep alleys that are typical of Liguria), artists' studios and frescoes that adorn the houses. Cervo, a little further away, is a beautiful village perched on top of a hill overlooking the sea. Don't miss it! In the village of Bordighera, you will find the northernmost palm grove in Europe and villas dating from the Liberty era (19th century).

Sanremo is certainly one of the most famous small towns on the Ligurian Riviera. In the past, it was frequented by the European aristocracy of the Belle Epoque. The golden years are now gone, but the city remains a pleasant place, especially for shopping, with a pleasant climate all year round. In the central street (Via Roma), near the casino, you will find all the best Italian brands. Just behind the casino, you will find the old town, called "Pigna", in fact a group of houses on the hill, with several small typical shops.

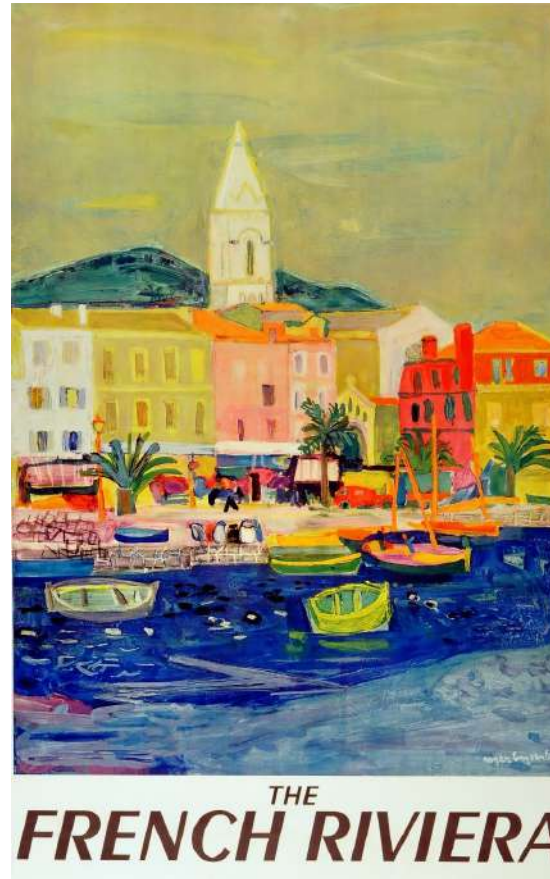


The Riviera's Timeless Allure for Artists

The Château Grimaldi: From a Noble Residence to Picasso Museum

Château Grimaldi, located on the site of the ancient Greek town of Antipolis, was once the home of the Monegasque noble family.

In 1966, it was transformed into the Picasso Museum, featuring several works and collections by the artist who lived there from September to November 1946.

During his stay, Picasso completed 23 paintings and 44 drawings which he later presented to the Town of Antibes. The museum's collection has since expanded with the addition of many other paintings.

The Maeght Foundation: A Unique Private Foundation in Europe

A collaborative effort between painters, artists, and architect Josep-Lluis Sert has resulted in an exceptional system of buildings and artworks. This includes the labyrinth of Miró, known for its sculptures and ceramics, Chagall's mosaics, Brail's glasses, and Bury's fountain.

The Maeght Foundation boasts one of the most prestigious collections in Europe of 20th-century art, featuring the works of Bonnard, Braque, Calder, Chagall, Giacometti, Léger, and Miró.

THE TOWN MUSEUMS

Matisse Museum: the museum is situated on the hill of Cimiez, not far from the Franciscan monastery with its gardens, the Hotel Regina, where Matisse lived, and the Gallo-Roman ruins. Since the 5th of January 1963 the Museum has been welcoming visitors who have been able to admire the collection of works left by the artist (and his heirs) to the city of Nice.



Chagall Museum: result of Chagall's donation to France, this museum built 1972 houses the most important permanent collection of the painter's work.



The Museum of Modern Art: designed by Bayard and Vidal, it presents French and American avant-garde movements from the 1960s to the present.



The Russian Cathedral: built in 1912, the Cathédrale Saint-Nicolas is famous for its six gilded onion domes and its façade of ochre brick. It is the biggest orthodox cathedral outside Russia.

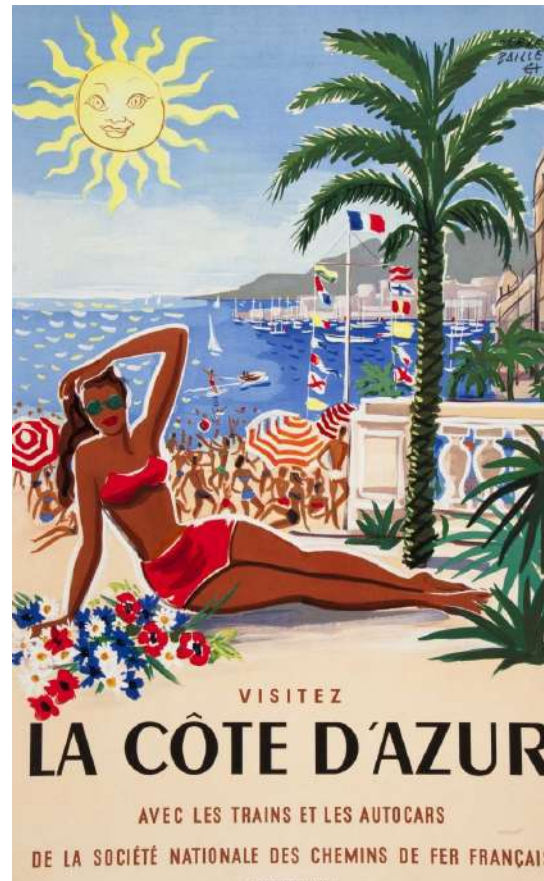
